The subject GRE in Mathematics is not required.</p> <p>Applicants must also complete the online application form http://grad.admissions.uiowa.edu/apply</p>	<p>One semester introductory proof based courses in both abstract algebra and analysis. A course in differential equations or numerical analysis.</p> <p>At least one year long sequence in one of the following: abstract algebra, real and complex analysis, or topology.</p> <p>Successful applicants typically have mostly A grades in their mathematics courses and a minimum overall GPA of 3.40.</p>	<p>Although our department does not have strict minimum requirements for GPA or GRE, successful applicants tend to have strong academic records. The graduate college requires a minimum 3.0 GPA.</p>	<p>We value REU participation and other research experiences in mathematics.</p> <p>Also, letters of recommendation play a critical role in the evaluation of applicants.</p>
